

Dear Cubmasters, Cub Scout Leaders and Others:

On behalf of the Order of the Arrow Wisiwanik Lodge 190 of the Arbuckle Area Council we would like to invite you and your pack to attend our first ever Cub Scout Adventure Day. The event will be on Saturday, October 8 from 12:30 p.m. to 5:30 p.m. on the campus of East Central University in Ada.

It will be for Tigers (must have an adult partner), Wolves, Bears, Webelos and Arrow of Light Scouts. The cost is \$10 for scouts registered before Wednesday, October 5 at 5:00 p.m. and \$15 for late registration and walk-ins. Every den/pack should have an adequate number of adults accompanying them throughout the day.

Please see the attached Cubmaster Information Book for much more information. Parents should complete and return to Cubmasters the registration form along with (if required by the pack-some packs will be paying the fee) their payment. Cubmasters should then transfer the information to the Pack Registration form (it is inside the information book) and send that form and your pack's payment to the council office as directed on the form. The forms parents completed should be submitted during check in at adventure day.

We will only be offering elective adventures at Cub Scout Adventure day so that Den Leaders can concentrate on the required adventures at home knowing that none of their scouts completed any of them at adventure day.

Scouts should eat lunch before they arrive and those planning to swim should WEAR their swimsuits and bring a towel, clothes to change into and a plastic bag for their wet clothes. By letting their scouts attend parents grant permission for their scout's picture to be taken and possibly used for different promotional purposes as well as for their scouts to use the internet under supervision.

At this time our hope is to repeat Cub Scout Adventure Day next year and in the years to follow at about the same time of year as this year's event. So, please let us (via Pat Fountain) know of any suggestions, concerns or problems before or after the event whether they concern this booklet, the event, ordering awards or anything else.
